Forensic Interviewer/Therapist - Part time (20 hrs/week), exempt - Working out of the Child Protection Center in Davenport, traveling to/from Muscatine as needed.

Responsible for conducting forensic interviews of children and adolescents alleging sexual abuse and providing individual brief, intensive therapy to child sexual abuse victims.

Duties: Conduct forensic interviews of children/adolescents alleging abuse as referred by DHS and/or law enforcement. Prepare formal reports of interviews for DHS and/or law enforcement. Respond to subpoenas and provide court testimony. Participate in case reviews and present cases. Assist the MVCPC Case Coordinator in collecting all relevant child/family history and making appropriate referrals. Maintain case records as appropriate. Provide individual therapy to child and adolescent victims of sexual abuse.
